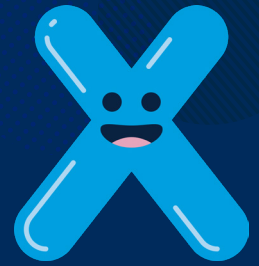




How to Register to

VOTE



To vote in South Africa elections, you need to register as a voter first.



Who can register as a voter?

- A South African citizen.
- Have a South African green barcoded identity document (ID), a smart ID card or a valid temporary ID certificate.
- Be 16 years or older (but you will only be able to vote when you are 18 years or older).
- Register in person or online.
- **Register where you live, and vote where you are registered.**

You should only update your details when:

- You have moved house and are living in a different voting district.
- You have been affected by the re-drawing of the voting district and/or ward boundaries.

Remember:

- **If you do not have your green barcoded ID book, a smart ID card or temporary ID, you need to apply for one at the Department of Home Affairs.**
- **Non citizens are not allowed to register to vote.**



Why should you register to vote?

- To be included on the national common voters' roll.
- If you don't register, you cannot vote, and if you don't vote, you are giving up a very important way of making your voice heard.
- It is your right and responsibility to register to vote.



Where can you register?

- At your local IEC office from Monday to Friday during office hours.
- At a registration station in the voting district in which you live, during a registration weekend.
- Online at: **registertovote.elections.org.za**.
- Voter registration is ongoing, so you can register at any time, whether an election is taking place or not.
- During the Targeted Communication and Registration (TCR).

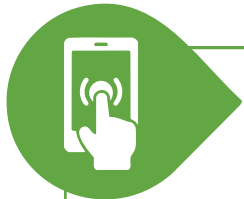
Online voter registration is safe, convenient and a real time facility.



How to register online?

1. Go to registertovote.elections.org.za;
2. Check and confirm your eligibility;
3. Enter your ID number, name and surname, contact details, and confirm OTP;
4. Capture your address details;
5. Upload a photo or copy of your SA ID – green ID book, smart ID or valid temporary ID; and
6. You will receive a notification that you have applied and are registered to vote within 24 hours.

NB: Providing an incorrect address is a criminal offense.



How to check if you are registered?

- Go to the IEC website www.elections.org.za and follow the link to “Check my Registration Status”.
- SMS ID number to 32810 (R1.00 per SMS).
- WhatsApp Hi: 060 088 0000.
- Call the IEC toll-free call centre 0800 11 8000 - only available during election periods.
- Use the IEC South Africa application on a smart phone.
- Visit your voting station during the Voter Registration Weekend or visit the local IEC office from Monday to Friday, during office hours.
